



CBHS Booster Club Meeting

WELCOME: Angela Evans called the meeting to order.

MINUTES: Members attending reviewed the Minutes. Teri Simmons made the motion to approve the minutes and a second from Tim DeVillez, all approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Jim Coffey provided an updated financial report giving a beginning balance of \$7818.33 from July 1, 2009 ending with \$7988.00 through October 12, 2009. We have sold 10 stadium chairs since 7/1/09, 5 of these were sold since our last meeting, leaving us with 19 stadium chairs left to sell. Our beginning balance as of 9/21/2009 was \$7968.33 and as of 10/12/2009 our ending balance is \$7988. Kathi Holsomback motioned for the financial report to be approved followed with a second from Allison Wright.

MEMBERSHIP: Chair Allison Wright asked everyone to encourage students and family members, soccer fans, friends and neighbors all to join the CBHS Soccer Booster Club – the more the merrier! Membership fees are \$25.00 per family or \$15.00 per individual.

FUNDRAISING:

Angela Evans will provide posters for the signs. Carwashing duty is reserved for the students, Parents volunteers are to provide supervision.

Football Concession – We signed up to work the CCISD Football concession stand on October 23, 2009. We must have 8 more volunteers. All volunteers must be at least 18 (and a High School Graduate.)

BBQ LUNCH SALES – Chairs Kelli Stercula and Tammy Pilola are getting ready for the first BBQ Sale this

Wednesday. Set up time will be a 9:30 a.m. we need baked goodies and drinks donated. Donations can be dropped off in the Entry office. The cost of \$4.00 will buy chips, a BBQ sandwich and a drink and baked goods can be bought for .50 a bag.

Brisket Sales - Chair Tim DeVillez has already been checking into purchasing briskets for our sale. It will cost about \$500.00 for 100 briskets. Discussion was held as to whether we should use the same company that we used last year, "Laid Back Cookers" or try Joe's in Alvin. The decision was to go with "Laid Back Cookers" and that the delivery day should be February 6, 2010 in time for Super Bowl Sunday!

Soccer Concessions - Chairs Shelley Sikes and Dawn Kahan asked that drink donations be turned in to them on Intro. night.

COACHES COMMENTS:

Coach Brewer – There will be 4 girls per room, approximately 7-8 rooms will be needed, and we will be taking a school bus to the tournament. We will stay 2 nights. Once the total amount is determined, Jim Coffey will be notified as to how much money we need. The date of the tournament is January 14th, 15th, and 16th of 2010. Varsity girls are picking out new warm ups to be purchased.

Coach Sickmiller - The boys are not going to need hotels because our tournaments are local. The Varsity Boys will be in Friendswood on January 7, 8, 9, 2010 and they will be in Pasadena on January 15, 16, 2010. The JV team will have a CCISD Tournament January 7, 8, and 9th and be at the Cy Fair Tournament on January 14, 15, 16, 2010. They may participate in a tournament at The Woodlands January 22, 23 2010. Our sophomore boys will be going to Lake Jackson January 22nd and 23rd, 2010. They will also participate in a tournament at Brazoswood. A discussion was held on whether or not to purchase warm up coats for the Boys. The plan is to purchase warm ups for the Varsity boys. They have rain gear already from a previous booster club purchase of 20 rain ponchos for the boys and 20 rain ponchos for the girls. (Look for Kios protectors?)The boys are selecting new jerseys. We purchased new bags for the boys last year. To answer the question of team funds; money for team expenditures rolls over to next year if not used. There will not be an alumni game.
